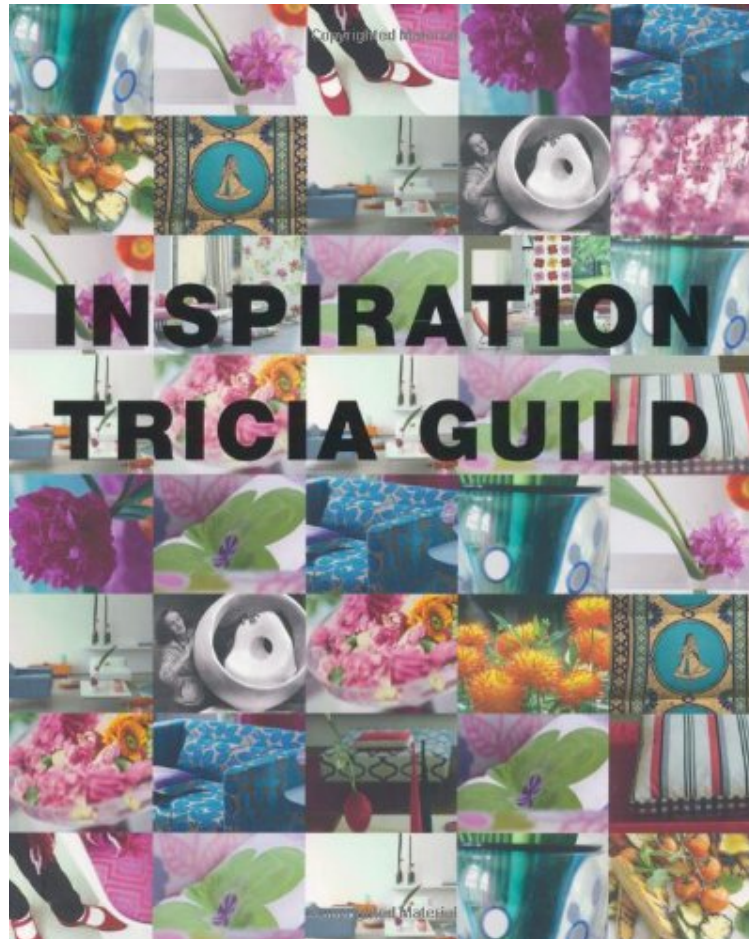

Most obviously, there's book design that perfectly juxtaposes images, topics and themes and provides just enough order so that the reader doesn't get lost among Guild's varied inspirations. The photography is stunning, and as always with Guild the colors are rich and vital. Best of all, for me at least, was the glimpse of Guild's creative life, seen in sharp relief through the diverse things that inspire her. It is a brightly festive book filled with celebrations of beautiful things in life including parrakeets, lemons, herbs and verandas.
