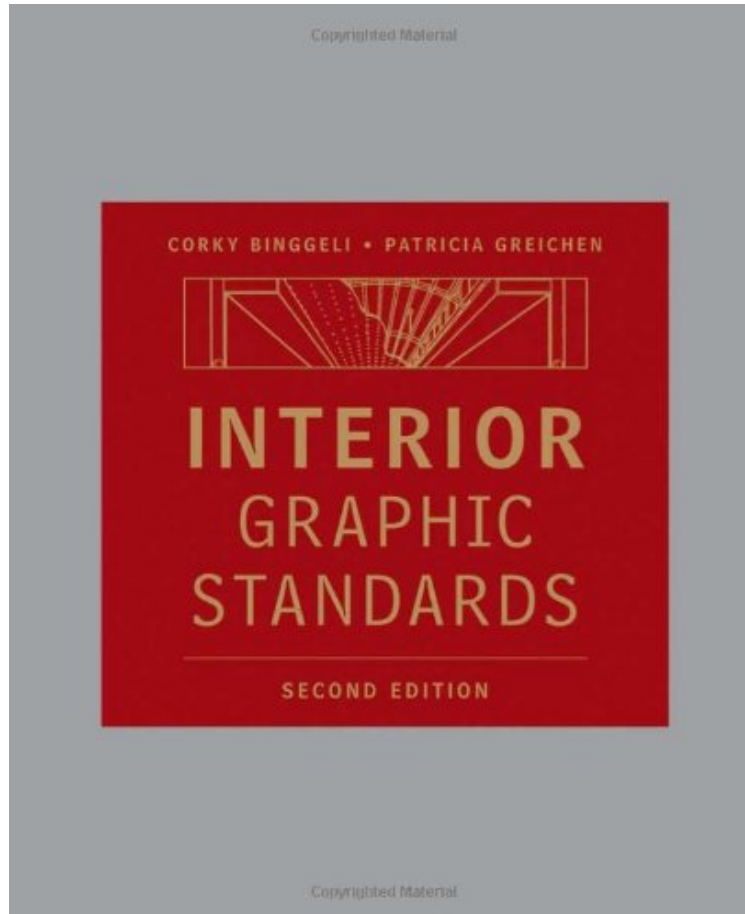

Turning to the table of contents was not that great either, as the toilet room layouts are under the chapter named 'SERVICES' in the 'PLUMBING SYSTEMS' section.
